A number of residents have expressed concern about various plants and hedges which are now over-grown and obstructing footpaths, pavements and roads.

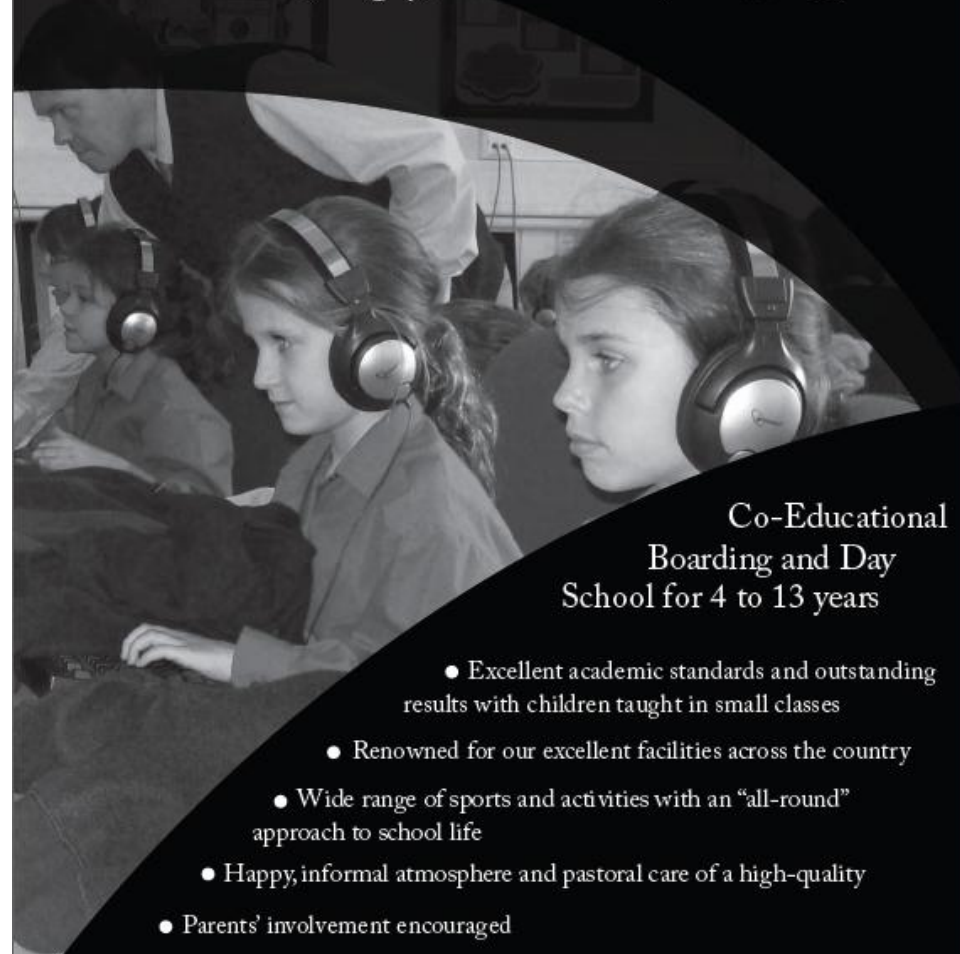
The Parish Council respectfully advises that it is the responsibility of all property owners to cut back any overgrown hedges and plant growth on their boundaries.

Bus Routes and Shelters.

One or two residents have asked if it would be possible to reroute the number 4 bus which at present goes along Calvestone Road. This is an excellent service but residents on the western side of the estate have some way to walk to get to a bus stop. We have spoken to Warwickshire County Council and Stagecoach on this subject. They tell us that due to the already tight timetabling on this route, a change would not be possible. An extra bus would be required if they were to cover the Cawston Grange Drive side of the estate, and this would require extra funding which is not at present available.

We have also been asked about the possibility of providing a bus shelter. There are four bus stops along Calvestone Road, and before we make any decision about if and where a bus stop would be appropriate, we are planning to ask residents' views on this as part of the Parish Plan discussed elsewhere in this issue.
